GOOFY ELECTED MAYOR High Turnout as Citizens Vote for Change

The people of Rabbit Hash, Kentucky, in a hotly contested three-way campaign, elected Goofy, a local resident since 1984, to the office of Mayor. A high turnout estimated at 90% of eligible voters and a series of very negative attack ads that alienated the constituents were primary factors contributing to his victory.

His opponents, Republicans Lester Huddle, Dogcatcher, and Franklin Washington, Rabbit Hash School District Board President, ran on anti-canine tickets. The backlash from the dog-loving public was unexpected and overwhelming.

"We believe that Rabbit Hash needs someone at the reins who can provide the know-how to revitalize our urban area," said Sam Blinmer, owner of Sam's Dollar Ninety Nine Store. Goofy has ties to the entertainment industry that could be helpful".

The campaign has generated interest in the surrounding counties. Charlene Musselfarg, owner of Charlene's Dresses 'N Blonde Wigs in nearby Skunk Creek, declared the sleeveless black vest back in style. "It's real popular right now with all them young guys over at the sawmill", said Ms. Musselfarg.

Over in Mayfield County, the residents of Pine Cone Holler have reportedly been wearing replicas of the Goofy-inspired Snipply SeaChef Hat, creating a surreal scene at public gatherings.
