## Florida Court Ok's Juvenile Weddings Justices Divided

In a 5/4 split vote, the Florida Supreme Court has upheld the Fundamentalist Youth Movement's challenge to legislation disallowing marriage between individuals who are under the age of legal responsibility. 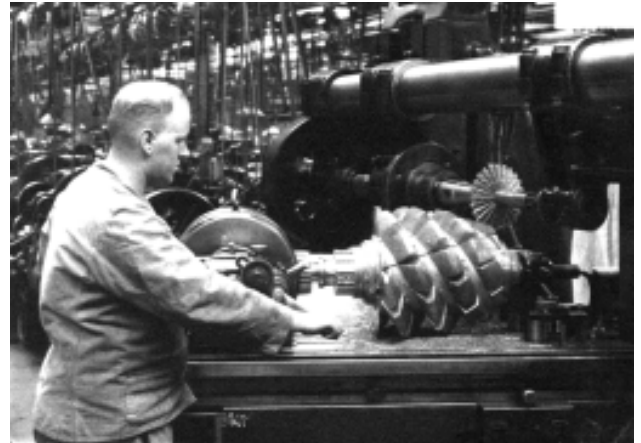
