# MILLION MIME MARCH! Demand Rights, Equal Pay, Tax Exemptions

AP\_\_Led by the charismatic Antoine Pirot, an organized march on Washington to press demands for improved social programs and increased benefits, estimated at nearly a million marchers, was met by counter demonstrations by groups from "I Don't Like Mimes", and "I Hate Clowns".

Pirot did not respond to questions except to pretend he was trapped in an invisible box. However, once he broke out of the box, he pantomimed cocking, pointing and firing a pistol, then doubled over in silent laughter.

A motly group of hand to mouth marchers from the Poor Mimes Faction mooned the line of mounted officers that were dispersed throughout the crowd, ostensibly to keep order. Threatened with arrest if they did it "one more time", the Poor Mimes backed off at the last minute and rejoined the march.

"The silence was eerie", said Anniston Layler, a Washington Post reporter covering the march. "I mean, here were all these people marching and the only noise was coming from the counter demonstrators".

The orderly demonstration was nearly derailed when a goth mime faction clashed with a group bused in from Hickory Wells, NC. The Committee to Erase Ungodliness attacked the goth mimes with smuggled-in baseball bats and silly string. Several inju-
