## MEDICAL MIRACLE

### Liplock Reversal Succeeds

Before Procedure

North Bergen, UPI. Local mechanic Harry Smitherington, 26, and heiress Lola Witherspoon, 38, were successfully disengaged from a category five liplock after several initial attempts by paramedics had failed.
