Gary Coleman Files Lawsuit

NCAA CRACKS DOWN

Responds to Complaints from Minorities

Canton, UPI. -- The NCAA Executive Committee has decided not to conduct championships on the campuses of member institutions where the use of nicknames and mascots representing American Indians and other minorities is considered hostile and abusive. The problem has surfaced among several other minority groups who have mobilized to protest what they consider demeaning mascots. The Warsaw College Fighting Polaks had to delay their opening practice when a large group of people, trucked in from South Milwaukee, stormed the practice fields, brandishing baseball bats and carrying signs. Stadislav Raskowski, the protesters' spokesperson explained. "We've been taking it on the chin for long enough. One more Polak joke, and I'm gonna go postal. Got it?"

Athletic Director Arnie Spieglehausen quipped, "We're here to play football, and you can call us anything you want. Now get the hell off my field."

The Pottstown College Picaninnies mascot, Buckwheat Simpson, Jr., expressed dismay at the controversy. "This is my job, mother*****, and I ain't givin' it up for nobody, you knowwa'am sayin'?"

His wife Doreen, the Cheerleading Advisor, attends every game, and is the creative force behind the Picaninnie Children's Workshop, the successful secondary education television tutoring program, ranking second behind Public Broadcasting's Teletubbies II, *We Got Game*.

Wilhelm Stronk, the new Executive Director of Mascots Are Dead, or MAD, noted that the crackdown should extend to high schools as well. He referred to the French Lick, Indiana, High School Garcons and the recent protest by the Orange County French Immigrant's Coalition.

"We have to protect every citizen's right to dignity and recognition of their unique contribution to society." He cited the action taken last month by the Red Cloud, Minnesota, High School Clodhoppers to defuse debate between supporters of the goofy farmboy mascot and PTA Parents for Christian Values. The School District simply canceled all sports competition. The feeling by many parents is that maybe the School District Supervisor took things too far, and have scheduled a meeting with Supervisor Eddie Muhamed to find another solution.
